Increasing awareness of type 1 diabetes clinical research studies in the New England region.

T1DTrials.org is a website that lists type 1 diabetes studies in New England.*

The listings on the website are categorized as follows:

New Onset Type 1 Diabetes Studies:

These studies focus on individuals soon after diagnosis of diabetes. Most often this is defined as within 3 months of diagnosis of diabetes but may vary from study to study so click on the individual Study Website link for the exact definition for a particular study. Many of these studies are designed to test if a treatment can prevent, delay, or reverse the progression of type 1 diabetes.

Family Member (At-Risk) Studies:

Through the Type 1 Diabetes TrialNet *Pathway to Prevention Study* family members of persons with type 1 diabetes may be eligible to have screening for diabetes risk including the testing of diabetes-related autoantibodies performed. Children as young as age 1 year may be eligible for screening through the *Pathway to Prevention Study*. Depending upon the results, additional testing and/or participation in a study to try and decrease the risk of progression to clinical diabetes may be offered.

Longer Duration of Diabetes Studies:

These studies focus on individuals who have established clinical diabetes. The duration from time of diagnosis for study eligibility varies so click on the individual Study Website link for the exact definition for a particular study. When available, studies for persons with latent autoimmune diabetes of adults (LADA) are most often included in this category.

*Only research studies for which there are no additional costs to participate are listed on T1DTrials.org. You are usually still responsible for non-study medical costs. Depending upon the study, a travel allowance and/or compensation for participation may be available.
